

Are you suffering from foot ulcers?

In Peripheral Artery Disease, blood vessels become narrowed and restrict blood flow to the legs. This can cause Critical Limb Ischemia – a condition in which you may experience pain even at rest, and/or develop ulcers, on your foot or leg.

The PACE study is examining an investigational therapeutic product in people with **Critical Limb Ischemia** due to **Peripheral Artery Disease**.

You may be able to take part in the study if you:*

- Are aged 45–99 years
- Are suffering from **Critical Limb Ischemia** (a loss of blood flow to the leg) due to atherosclerosis (thickening of the blood vessel walls) that causes foot ulcers.
- Are not suitable for a procedure to open the obstructed blood vessels or bypass surgery

All study-related treatment and follow-up will be provided at no charge to you. You will receive close monitoring by expert doctors who are experienced in treating Critical Limb Ischemia.
