PISCES III is a clinical research study to determine whether stem cells injected into a damaged area of the brain can improve arm and/or leg movement in people with ongoing disability after an ischemic stroke (a stroke that occurs when blood flow to the brain is blocked, such as by a clot).

### WHAT ARE STEM CELLS?

Stem cells are cells early in the tissue development pathway that have the potential to develop into more specialized cells such as nerve cells. In many tissues they act as an internal repair system.

### **HOW DO I KNOW IF I AM ELIGIBLE?**

### You may be eligible to participate if you:

- Had an ischemic stroke 4 to 11 months ago that has resulted in limited movement of your arms and/or legs.
- Are between 35 and 75 years of age.
- Are willing to undergo a single surgical procedure and attend pre-surgery and post-surgery visits.
- Are able to perform physical therapy exercises daily at home for 12 weeks and attend follow-up visits at the study site every couple of months for approximately one year.
